GENERAL DETAILS:

- **DOGS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME** (You will be asked to leave the grounds.)
- Maps and body numbers will be provided. RIDERS TO SUPPLY BODY NUMBER HOLDERS. Body numbers to be worn whilst on course.
- All riders must have a current Pony Club card, not necessarily for horse entered.
- Approved hard hats, riding boots and medical arm bands must be worn by all riders.
- Pony Club gear safety check will be required for ALL riders.
- Multiple entries are permitted from one rider. Please send one form for each combination you enter.
- Instructors are welcome, but if mounted, must pay appropriate entry fees for each grade.
- Cross Country course will be open to walk from 8am on the day.
- Cross Country jumps must only be jumped in the configuration they are flagged. You may jump one grade either side of the grade entered providing it is safe—be aware of other riders.
- Riders riding dangerously, deliberately getting in other rider's way or jumping jumps that are not permitted will be asked to leave the course.
- Catering (basic) will be available on the day.
- **COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO BRING WATER FOR THEIR HORSES, BOTH FOR DRINKING AND WASHING.**
- Entry Fee: Pony Club & Adult PC \$20 (late fee \$10)
- Refunds after close of entries only with medical or vet certificate within 7 days of the event.
